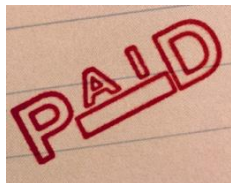

Our Devon Suns are going very well.

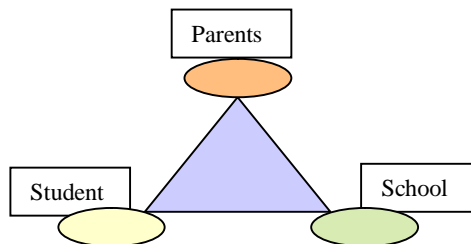
Results from Friday 7th vs Highlands Heat = Devon 33 Highlands 42 - our aim is to win this game next time!
