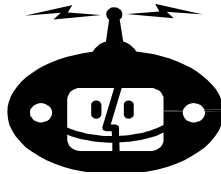

KELLY SPORTS JULY SCHOOL HOLIDAY PROGRAMME

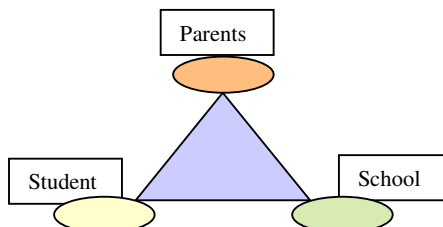
