BUILDING PROJECT

We have action! The contractors are on site and demolition of the burnt out library has begun! South Coast Construction are the successful tenderer and will be at school for the next 8 months working through a number of planned works, starting with the reinstatement of the library and administration area.

As well as the refurbishment of two classroom blocks and the outside toilets, building of a brand new Northern Health School, demolition of Rooms 1 & 2 which have been identified as leaky buildings and the old prefabs, there is some earthquake strengthening in the hall and an upgrade of our heating and security system to be completed.

As large parts of our school will be a construction site, we do ask that parents DO NOT COME DOWN THE SCHOOL DRIVE IN CARS TO DROP OFF AND PICK UP STUDENTS PLEASE. There will be heavy machinery operating within the grounds and we want to keep the area at the bottom of the drive as clear as possible.

The Bonithon Avenue carpark will also be CLOSED UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE. This will be used exclusively for access by the contractors.

We are hoping to keep disruption to a minimum but there will be times when classes will have to move out of their own classrooms to allow contractors to work on them. We will keep you informed as we know more.
