IS YOUR CHILD AWAY?

It is important to let the school know if your child will be absent for the day. Below are the guidelines which need to be followed:

- State his/her room number
- State the reason for his/her absence
- If the absence is likely to be for more than one day, please indicate the length of time for the proposed absence. Should you receive a message querying the absence please phone/text the office. If we do not receive a response from you your child will be marked as being truant.

It is important that you provide us with up-to-date contact details for your child, especially in cases of emergencies.

ATTENDANCE REMINDERS

If you know that your child is going to be late to school, e.g. a doctor's appointment, please inform your child's teacher, please call the office before 8.45am or write a note for them to hand when they sign into the office. If you do not do this, your child will be marked as late and unexplained. It also means they will be expected to complete a reflection at lunchtime and will not meet expectations for that day.
