Welcome to Term 3 and our production term. We are excited to let you all know that we will be holding our school production "Oz" in September with practices already under way. We will be holding a matinee performance on Tuesday 19th September and evening performances on 20th and 21st September. We look forward to seeing you all there to celebrate our student's hard work.

Of concern is the small number of students who have been bullying others. This behaviour is not acceptable at Devon Intermediate and if we know about it, we act immediately. Recently we have had parents approach us to let us know that their child has been being bullied and I thank you for this. If we are not informed we cannot address the behaviours with the bully. A reminder that bullying is defined as:

"Bullying is unwanted, aggressive behaviour that involves a real or perceived power imbalance. The behaviour is repeated, or has the potential to be repeated, over time"

Students do need to tell an adult if this is happening so that we can act. Comments such as 'everyone is bullying me' or the school is 'doing nothing' are not correct as the actions we take are with the bully and his or her family and not made public.

To help our students form positive relationships, we have invited a group from the Parenting Place to join us next week. There is a cost to this, but as we believe it is important for all students to attend these presentations, the school is covering the cost.

The Friendship Factor, is delivered by the Attitude group and promotes the message to students that they need to build healthy and positive friendships to be successful in life. The presentation includes skills and strategies for building friendships, handling rejection, conflict and bullying. During the 50 minute session humour, storytelling and visuals will be utilised to engage our students with the content.

We enjoyed hosting Highlands Intermediate this week for our final winter sports exchange. While we had limited wins, I was extremely impressed with our teams' sportsmanship and welcoming behaviour. The students who were involved are a credit to the school and their families.

We are holding our Parent information evening for prospective parents on August 22nd. The evening starts at 6.30pm with an informal meet and greet followed by presentations at 7pm. Please let friends and families of Year 6 students know this information.

We have been extremely fortunate to be gifted a classroom full of computers by Power Co. A huge thank you to Brigitte Colombo and Michael Tudor from Power Co for making this happen as it will benefit all of our students.
