Devon Intermediate is holding our Graduation Ball in the school hall on Thursday 8th December from 6:00pm. The event will be a formal evening, with a variety of structured dances, a sit down meal served by waiters and will be concluded by the presentation of Graduation Certificates. As the event is formal there will be a dress code:
