What an awesome start to Term 1 2018 at Devon Intermediate. It was fantastic to see so many family and friends at the powhiri on Wednesday to support our incoming Year 7 students.

It is my pleasure to introduce our new staff members for 2018. Miss Kynoch is in Room 11, Mr Miller in Room 10, Miss Lynskey is our new Food tech teacher, Mr Carey is the Wood work teacher and Mrs Snyder is our new Librarian.

A few reminders and dates for your information.

Please can we **not** have parents driving down the driveway to deliver students before and after school unless there is a medical reason which means they cannot walk down the drive. We have about 325 students leaving and arriving and most of them use the driveway leading up to Devon Street. If you are picking your child up from the other side of Devon Street, we ask that the students cross at the controlled crossing and not run across the road to your car. There was a very close shave on Wednesday when a student was almost hit by a truck when they ran across the road without looking rather than walking 10 metres down the road to the crossing.

Our Meet the Teacher evening will be held on Thursday 15th February. Parents/whanau are to meet in your child's class by 5.30pm and teachers will then give a half hour over view of the plans for the year and questions can be answered. We encourage whanau to bring a picnic tea (if the weather is suitable) and we will have the pool open for whanau to swim but you must supervise your children. The evening will finish by 7 pm.

A reminder to all whanau that school will close at 2.30pm on Tuesdays for the staff to be involved in intensive PD and meetings. Bus children may wait in the library for the buses to arrive. We have adjusted the break times to ensure you child is still having almost the same amount of classroom time. The YMCA do offer Out of School Care and do pick up from Devon Intermediate on a daily basis. Application forms can be collected from the school office.

A reminder also that school will be closed this **Monday 5th February** for a teacher only day.

Term 1 and 4 uniform means the students should be wearing correct school sandals. I am concerned that we have some students wearing incorrect uniform and are wearing their winter uniform, I would really appreciate your help with this to ensure all students are representing Devon Intermediate to the highest standard.

SCHOOL DIARIES

All students have been issued with a Devon Intermediate Home and School Diary. The cost is \$10 which is payable to the school office. This diary is an important communication tool between home and school and we encourage parents/caregivers to write notes in it. It is also a key organisational tool in which students will record their homework and other reminders.

Clear communication between home and school is vital to enable us to do the very best we can for your children. SWIMMING PROGRAMME

Swimming is a compulsory component of the Physical Education curriculum and the focus of our Term 1 programme. It is important that students are prepared for swimming each day by having the appropriate swimwear. They need to bring named togs and towel. Goggles and/or rash shirts are optional. For safety reasons, students will not be permitted to be in the pool in shorts, tee shirts or other clothing. If there is a medical reason your child is unable to swim for the day, the appropriate section needs to be completed in the school diary.

A reminder that you should ensure all school uniform items are clearly marked with the student's name. We suggest that the sun hats are marked using a Twink pen. As part of the summer school uniform, all students are required to have a school navy, wide-brimmed or bucket hat. These hats are available from the school office for just \$10 each new, or second-

hand \$5 each. Hair is expected to be neat and tidy – **no**

way-out styles or colours will be permitted.
