We are all part of the Mighty Green Discovery team and are looking forward to working together and gaining lots of house points.



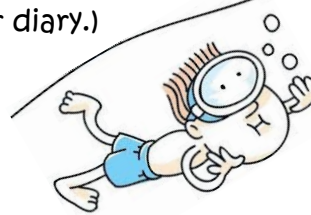

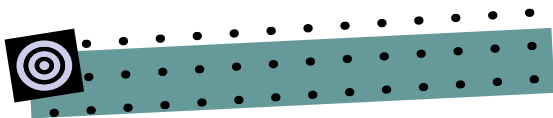
