We are quickly heading towards the end of term 2 and we have a few events we would like to inform you of before we finish for the term at 3pm on Friday 5<sup>th</sup> July. A reminder that Term 3 starts at 8.40am on July 22<sup>nd</sup> and we look forward to

welcoming all students back to school on the Monday.

The year 8 Taster Day at Spotswood College will now be held on Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> July following its postponement this week. We will also have our MANA day on Friday 5<sup>th</sup> July for those students who are eligible.

Out final winter sports exchange for this term will be held next Tuesday 2 July against Hawera Intermediate and it will be held here at Devon. It would be great to see parents and supporters at the school cheering on our teams.

Last week's Lock Down highlighted some areas I would like parents to take note of. Our student management system sent an alert to parents that we were in lock down and it became overloaded which is why some parents did not receive the alert. We are working to mitigate this issue. It did, however, highlight the need for the school to have correct contact details. If you have changed your phone numbers or addresses, could you please notify the school office. When we are in lock down I would ask that parents do not come to the school to see your child. While I totally understand how scary these sorts of events are for parents, our priority is the safety of your child, and it makes it difficult for the school to have to try and stop parents wandering around the school during the lock down and we are then needing to ensure the safety of the parents as well. I am quite happy for you to contact the school or to come to the office once the lock down is lifted if you feel the need to check on your child. I would also like to ask parents to reiterate to their child the need for them to keep safe. Walk in pairs or groups to and from school, if they feel uneasy about a member of the public then go to a safe place quickly and to notify an adult.

Next term is also going to be busy with our last winter sports exchange with Highlands being held at Devon on August 6<sup>th</sup>. We have High School information meetings and enrolments for the Year 8's and we will be holding our information evening for prospective parents of Devon on Thursday August 29<sup>th</sup>. The AIMS games team will be away in September and we will also be showcasing our school to ERO from September 16<sup>th</sup>. The last two weeks of term 3 will be camp weeks, and a reminder that if your child is going to camp, the deposit is required now.

We will be farewelling Mr Lancaster at the end of the term as he is relocating to Auckland and we will be welcoming Mrs Ngaia to Devon Intermediate at the start of Term 3.

We are now taking enrolments for 2019 and enrolment packs can be collected from the office. A reminder that Devon Intermediate is not zoned so we can accept enrolments from throughout Taranaki.
