Welcome to the first newsletter for 2020. We send out one newsletter a month to keep you informed of the comings and goings at Devon Intermediate and we also use our Facebook page or School Loop App to keep everyone up to date with what is happening at our amazing school. It was fantastic to see so many parents and whanau at our Powhiri held to welcome our new students. Our school roll is approximately 430 and we have decided, in order to keep them safe as they enter and leave the school, we will be locking the Devon Street school gate between 8.15am and 8.45am and 3.00pm and 3.15pm. In the past we have repeatedly asked parents not to come down the drive to drop off and pick up their child for safety reasons. If there is a medical reason which requires your child to be dropped at the school office, please call the school and speak to Mrs. Gellen.

During the holidays I received the resignation of Ms. Sonja Ngaia who was to be teaching in Room 20. We have been very fortunate to welcome Miss Jacinta Radford to our staff to replace Ms. Ngaia.

Term one brings with a flurry of events including our school photos on February 17th, our Standards Swimming sports which will be held on Friday 21st February as well as our Championships Swimming sports which will be held on Friday 28th February. We welcome everyone to come and watch these events which start about 1pm.

Please note, school WILL be open on Friday 7th February. The Board have approved Teacher Only Days to be held on June 26th and October 23rd this year.

My thanks to all those parents who attended the Pathways and Planning meetings which were held prior to the start of school. I hope meetings were valuable to both you and your child and ensured they were excited about joining us at Devon Intermediate.

Thursday 5th March will see us holding our first hui. Information will be given regarding both the MANA and Attitude for Excellence programmes and it will also give you an opportunity to catch up with your child's teachers to see how they have settled in to life at Devon Intermediate. The evening will start at 5 pm in the hall with groups splitting off to find out about MANA and Attitude for Excellence, or for you simply to catch up with the teachers. You are more than welcome to bring your own picnic and enjoy our school pool (if the weather is suitable). Our Parent Link group will be running a sausage sizzle, selling ice blocks and drinks also. The evening will conclude at 7pm. You may wish to join us for the whole, or just part of the evening.

A reminder also that school concludes at 2.30pm every Tuesday for staff to be involved in Professional Development courses. SCHOOL FEES 2020

Devon Intermediate Board of Trustees removed the cost of the school donation in line with the 2019 Budget Announcement, whereby the school is subsidised \$150 per student for school expenses.

The annual cost to cover, Food, Wood, Art, Digital Technology and Performing Arts take home consumables have been reduced to just \$20.00 per student this year.

SWIMMING PROGRAMME
