Kia ora Whanau

Devon Intermediate is committed to keeping your child safe and well. With the COVID 19 announcement last night, we are moving to Level 2. The following protocols will be back in place as of 12pm today.

Classes will be running on the normal timetable with all children expected in class at 8.40am and finishing at 3 pm with the exception of Tuesdays where we finish at 2.30, as normal.

As stated earlier, we have processes and procedures in place to ensure your child's continued health and safety at school. We do ask that if your child is in the slightest bit ill, that they DO NOT come to school. Please notify the school on the absence line.

We also ask that children are reminded to adhere to social distancing where they can and that they don't congregate at the school gates.

Due to the seriousness of COVID 19 and in order to ensure the physical and mental wellbeing of both students and staff, we introduced the following procedure:

Any student who coughs or spits at others, or who claims to have COVID 19, will be sent home immediately and will not be allowed to return to school until they produce a clear COVID test.

We understand that some students can make silly comments, but in the current pandemic climate, we will be having a zero tolerance approach to COVID related bullying or claims.

The drinking fountains have been blocked off and we ask that students bring their own named drink bottle from home.

Parents are encouraged not to pick up their child from within the school grounds and to not come to the classroom.

With our school gate being closed in the afternoons, the YMCA van will pick students up from above the gate until such time things change. Please reiterate this to your child that this is where they need to meet the van, staff will remind them today.

In the event you need to visit the school office, if your query cannot be addressed over the phone or by email, can you please ensure you practice social distancing.

In the event that we are asked to close in the future, we will provide work for classes which will be in the form of on-line or hard packs as we know not all our families have access to the internet and data.

The student body was reminded today to follow good hygiene habits, stay healthy and active and to look out for each other. Once again, if your child is sick, please keep them at home, otherwise we look forward to seeing them in class and learning
