

STUDENTS ARRIVING LATE/ABSENCES

We are having a large number of students arriving late everyday. Students should be on school grounds at 8.30am and in class no later than 8.40am each day.

There is a well-recognised link between attendance at school and student achievement. Every day that students are not at school, is a lost opportunity to learn.

Ministry of Education guidelines describe a justified absence as being illness, attending a tangi or funeral or representation at a provincial or national level in a sporting or cultural event. All other absences are considered to be unjustified, even if the absence is explained.

If you child is late to school they must report to the office for a late slip. Please ensure that they have a written note giving a reason for their lateness or please phone or use the Skool Loop app to communicate with us in the office. Phone 758 5266.

A MESSAGE FROM TREES FOR SURVIVAL

We are still on the hunt for suitable host landowners for our students to plant next season, being May to August, 2023. More can be found at https://www.tfsnz.org.nz/ or email Kim@tfsnz.org.nz for more information.

We are looking for privately owned land for a conservation project in close proximity to your schools. Ideally big enough to sustain the children re-visiting and planting at the same location for 2-4 years. Our children are raising 800 - 1000 Native Plants per year. There is a mixture of trees, grasses and flaxes, all suitable riparian plants (sourced seed from Taranaki). Suitable farms would be those wanting to revegetate erosion prone banks, streams and wetland areas.

All to improve our environmental habitats, water quality, protect our native fauna/ flora to flourish, and continue to help our children to engage practically in the conservation projects. Hopefully this may provide some opportunities for St Joseph's and Devon Intermediate schools come next year.
