



INTERNATIONAL STUDENT SAFETY POLICY

No 611

Rationale

The safety of international students is a critical issue given that the school has ultimate responsibility for the student's welfare.

Guidelines

1. Parents and are expected to -
 - notify the school immediately when their student is absent from school
 - notify the International Student Coordinator urgently if a student's behaviour causes concern

School Response

2. Where a student's behaviour causes concern the school will -
 - bring the matter to the attention of the international students' parents.
 - follow the school's procedures relating to discipline

Initially the student will be interviewed by the International Student Coordinator who may use a range of intervention strategies which could include -

- referral to the Team Leader for action
- informing the Principal
- involve outside counseling, including the use of an interpreter
- students will be subjected to normal school disciplines actions
