PLANTING OUR PLACE—NGA MANU PIKOKO ROOPU O TE KURA TAKAWAENGA O NGAMOTU Tauira (students) aged from 9-13 year olds who came from the surrounding kura of Mangaotuku Awa were Marfell Primary, Spotswood Primary, Te Pi'ipi'inga Kakano Mai I Te Rangiatea and Devon Intermediate School were involved in planting our place in conjunction with NPDC and Te Ara Taiao.

Tauira gained a deeper understanding of kaitiakitanga and to help restore the mauri of the ngahere and Mangaotuku Awa by planting a variety of native Rākau to watch them grow for the next generation to enjoy.

Devon Intermediate Kura Year 7 Tauira are a part of Ngā Manu Pīkoko roopu who worked with Spotswood Primary showing them how to plant rākau in the reserve along Mangaotuku Awa, about 30 Tauira planted around 300 rakau in the morning. Another 50 Tauira from Te Pi'ipi'ng Kakano Mai I Te Rangiatea and Marfell Primary planted around 600 natives between them in the afternoon, a massive effort put in by Tauira, Kaiako and support teachers and parents. A Community push was on Sunday with 30 volunteers planting about 2000 native rakau. 0.4 hectares planted in native Rākau over two days.
